

## Mission Work in Cameroon

Laurel has supported mission working Cameroon since 1999. This work, coordinated by the Buckingham Road church of Christ in Garland, Texas, is focused on evangelism throughout the nation of Cameroon in West Africa. Specifically the Laurel congregation now supports Brother Jean-Claude Ethe the preacher at the Douala Town Church of Christ that meets at Cite de la Paix in Duoala, Cameroon. In addition to his preaching duties in Duoala Brother Jean-Claude is involved in evangelism throughout all of Cameroon.

Jean-Claude travels throughout Cameroon using his multi-lingual skills of French, Pidgen, and English to convert souls and help establish churches. He also serves as the coordinator of World Bible School correspondence courses in Cameroon.

In 2002, 2004, 2007, 2008 and 2009, members of the Laurel congregation participated in campaigns in the South-West and Northwest provinces of Cameroon. In these campaigns, coordinated by Brother Jim Corner from Buckingham Road, individual Christians work with small congregations to study the Bible with student prospects in a one-on-one basis and to teach and preach among the brethren. Throughout these campaigns hundreds of Bible studies have taken place and almost one hundred individuals have been baptized.

The Laurel church hopes to contribute to this work into the future.
